BUSHFIRE MITIGATION WORKS 2025-2026 UPDATE FOR RESIDENTS NEAR MARNIE ROAD

Further to our mailed letter dated 14 July 2025, advising of planned bushfire mitigation works across multiple locations throughout the Shire, funded through the State Government's Mitigation Activity Funds Grant Program (MAFGP), we are writing to provide an update specific to your area.

Works along the section of Marnie Road, from Helena College to Lionel Road, are expected to be undertaken during the school holidays, commencing on or around 6 April 2026, and are anticipated to take approximately 4 days, subject to weather and contractor availability.

Scope of Works

The works (refer to map on reverse) will comprise verge mulching within both the made and unmade sections of the road reserve, to improve separation and alter the fuel structure to help slow the spread of fire. This will assist in making the roadway safer for public vehicles and emergency service appliances during a bushfire emergency.

Works will also include the removal of selected vegetation, primarily environmental weeds such as invasive wattles and tagasaste, for fuel load reduction.
