NOTICE OF PLANNED BURNING - RESERVE 39853, WOOROLOO

Shire of Mundaring advises that its Fire Protection Officers, supported by local Volunteer Fire Brigades and Department of Fire and Emergency Services staff, are planning to carry out a hazard reduction burn in Shire managed Reserve 39853, weather conditions permitting.

The planned burn area is in the southern section of the reserve, near Dunham Glen and Needham Road in Wooroloo. This follows a successful hazard reduction burn completed in the northern section of the reserve in 2025. A map of the planned burn area is provided on the reverse side of this letter.

Due to the need for suitable weather conditions, the exact date of the burn cannot be confirmed in advance. However, the burn is planned to take place between Monday, 4 May 2026 and Sunday, 31 May 2026.

The purpose of the burn is to reduce bushfire hazard to nearby private properties, the reserve itself, and the surrounding community. It will also help improve conditions for firefighters if a bushfire occurs in the area. This work forms part of the Shire's broader bushfire mitigation program to help protect life, property and the environment.

The burn will be carefully planned and managed by fire crews. However, residents should be aware that smoke may be generated during the burn and could affect nearby properties and surrounding roads for a period of time.

Fire crews will monitor the burn closely, and patrols will continue afterward to ensure the area remains safe. Residents are asked to avoid entering the burn area for several days after the operation, as trees and branches may be weakened by fire and could fall without warning.
