Youth Engagement Partnership Fund

Applications are now open for the Shire's Youth Engagement Partnership Fund. The fund aims to assist not-for-profit community groups to plan an event or program for 12 to 18 year olds – such as a movie night, concert, skills workshop or holiday program – within the Shire of Mundaring.

The 2019/2020 funding round closes on 30 April 2020. It is only the second time the Shire has offered these grants with previous grants supporting sports programs, art workshops, drama workshops and a health and wellbeing directory. Organisations who are based outside of the Shire are eligible to apply if the proposed activity is held within the Shire.
