

Recover Together COVID-19 Relief & Recovery Fund - Closing Soon



Community groups and local businesses facing challenges because of the coronavirus pandemic can now apply for grants through Shire of Mundaring's Recover Together – COVID-19 Relief and Recovery Fund.

The Fund aims to help the Shire partner with community members to deliver a range of programs and initiatives that build community resilience and connectedness.

The following funding is available for programs/activities that commence by 30 June 2021:

Restart Grant - up to \$500 - for small initiatives and items that will assist in recovery and 'restarting'.

Reconnect Grant - \$501 to \$2500 - supports initiatives that benefit community groups and their members and local business and industry.

Rebuild Grant - \$2501 to \$10,000 - supports initiatives that are of wider community or economic benefit.

Resilience Grant - \$10,000+ - available for large-scale initiatives that will generate broad community or economic benefit.

Community Grant Program

Upcoming grant rounds for 2021 are as follows:

Community Event Grant - Grants are awarded up to a maximum of \$5000 for groups wishing to run fetes, festivals, markets, sporting/recreational carnivals, exhibitions, small performances and training related to the event.

Applications are invited for community events to be held between May and October 2021.

Opening - 12 February 2021

Closing - 15 March 2021



Matching Grant - Grants are awarded up to a maximum of \$2000 for projects meeting the needs of the local community. Groups must be able to match Shire funding dollar for dollar.

Opening - 12 February 2021

Closing - 15 March 2021

Quick Grant - This grant offers up to \$500 to community groups for the purchase of small equipment, training and any other small projects that benefit the community.

Opening - 16 April 2021

Closing - 17 May 2021
